Confirm the date for the Cardigan Bay Rally Get Connected

Organisers are delighted to confirm that the Cardigan Bay Rally Get Connected will be held for the second time over the weekend 3 and 4 September 2022, with the only closed road stages rally in Wales returning After a break from three years.

After the very successful first rally in September 2019, the aim was to be an annual occasion. But as many other events, the unprecedented circumstances have meant that the event wasn't possible in 2020 and 2021. So, at a time of continued uncertainty for events organisers, the announcement today is considered a very positive step establishing a realistic date.

" We are delighted to announce what we consider as a target that we can work towards confidently ", says the chair of the Cardigan Bay Rally Rally Committee Get Connected, Phil Pugh.

" Our aim during this time was to arrange the rally when the time was right, and not before then. The rally had a warm reception when it was held in September 2019, and we intend to build on that good name for 2022. Of course, we can't achieve this without the support of the local community; residents, businesses , authorities, emergency services and the public.

" Therefore, we will use the time we have ahead of us effectively. It will enable us to provide a great experience for competitors, spectators and commercial partners - and another unforgettable weekend for everyone involved in the event!"

Once again, the Cardigan Bay Rally Get Connected will start and finish in Aberystwyth, and its close connections to the town University will continue. Organisers promise an extended path for 2022 which will be, as before, including a series of challenging and inspiring special stages timed on closed roads over the Cambria mountains.
