1 ANNOUNCEMENT

Rhyl & District Motor Club Ltd. will promote a **Clubman permit Autotest** and a **Clubman Production Car Autotest** on **Sunday 29th March 2020** at the Port of Mostyn Docks, Mostyn, Flintshire, CH8 9HE

2 JURISDICTION

The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

All Marshals & Officials are Judges of Fact, with regard to test penalties and their decision will be final.

5 ELIGIBILITY

All drivers **must produce a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman Licence** and an invited club membership card. **An RS Clubman Licence is required in line with current Motorsport UK regulations** and is **free** on application to Motorsport UK .

The Autotest and the Production Car Autotest is open to fully elected members of the promoting club, all registered contenders of the ANWCC Championship. It is open also to the members of the following clubs:-

Caernarvon & Anglesey MC, Clwyd Vale Motor Club, Bala Motor Club, Knutsford Car Club.	North Wales Car Club; 116 Car Club, Boughton & Bretton Motor Club, Harlech Motor Club
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Entry is also open to a maximum of 7 additional Motorsport UK registered clubs on a first come first served basis.

6 MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS

Autotest

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are aged 16 years and over, who do not have a valid RTA Licence, but they may only drive a touring car up to 1400 cc (forced induction is not permitted).

Production Car Autotest

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are aged 14 years and over at the date of the event without a full RTA Licence, providing the engine capacity is less than 2000cc including forced induction (M17 and M22) and the passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be experienced at Autotesting or Autosolo.

9 CLASSES

Autotest

- A/1** Saloon Cars, that are not taxed or tested
A/2 Sports Cars and Specials
A/3 Road-going saloon cars -- being defined as cars that are fully road legal

Cabriolet Saloons – will run in the appropriate saloon class, or Sports car class with hood down

Production Car Autotest

- PCA/1** Production Saloon and Sports Cars up to 1400cc
PCA/2 Production Saloon and Sports Cars over 1400cc

All Cars

Tyres must have a minimum depth tread of 1.6mm at the start of the event.

Tyres in list 1B & 1C of the Motorsport UK Regulations on Permitted Tyres (L) are not permitted (M4.7). List 1B and 1C is available on line at <https://www.motorsportuk.org/196-205-Permitted-Tyres-Lpdf>.

10 ENTRIES

Entries open on publication of these SR's and close at 20.00 hours on Wednesday **25th March 2020**.

The maximum number of entries for the entire meeting will be 40 and the minimum will be 20 entries, under which the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

A car may be shared by up to drivers and must be entered on two separate entry forms. A driver however may not compete in more than one car.

An entry fee of £35 or a reduced fee of £25 for any driver under 18 years of age on the date of the event.

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 years and over who do not have a valid , full RTA Licence subject to_

- The vehicle must be a "Touring Car"
- The vehicle engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc including forced induction
- A passenger must be carried who holds a valid full RTA Licence and be an experienced in Autotests or AutoSolos

11 FINAL INSTRUCTIONS#

Final Instructions will be posted via email provided and will also be posted on the Club web site (www.rhyldmc.co.uk)

12 TESTS

Details of all tests will be published on the Club website (www.rhyldmc.co.uk) Hard copy will also be provided in competitor starter packs at signing on.

There will be three test sites with two tests on each, and three runs at each test all counting towards the results. However this will be subject to the number of entries and any adverse weather conditions on the day.

Timing will be by hand-held stop watches timed to the previous 1/10 of a second

Start signal will be "In your own time" and commences when front wheels cross the start line. Timing will finish when you stop astride the finish line.

Test layouts will be depicted by cones which may be less than 1m in height.

It will not be deemed a wrong test, if the driver returns to the point of deviation and then completes the course correctly.

A stop signal (Waving of a Red Flag) will be deployed if there is an obstruction on the test . A competitor must stop immediately and a re-run will be allowed

If a competitor experiences a puncture or deflated tyre on a test, they must stop immediately to avoid damage to test area surface. In this instance a re-run will not be allowed and a maximum penalty awarded.

13 PENALTIES

A]	Not attempting a test run, or failing to attempt a test when instructed to do so	Maximum *
B]	Wrong Test / False Start	Maximum *
C]	Striking a pylon / cone.	5 Seconds
D]	Failing to cross / stop at penalty line	5 Seconds
E]	Every second or fraction taken	1 (and tenths)
F]	Striking the boundary of a test area	5 Seconds
G]	Abusive language, or behaviour, or practicing	1 st Offence 10 Seconds 2 nd Offence Disqualification
H]	Aggressive driving, handbraking or speeding Over 5 mph on the site whilst not on a test	1 st Offence 10 Seconds 2 nd Offence Disqualification

For (A) & (B) the maximum penalty is the lowest penalty incurred by any competitor in the class making an attempt correctly on that run plus 20 seconds. The maximum penalty (including time) for any test cannot exceed A & B above.

If a driver returns to the point of their mistake and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply.

14 RESULTS

Provisional results will be published at the event control trailer as soon as possible after the completion of the last test.

Any protest must be in accordance with Motorsport UK regulation

In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie then the fastest on the second run until a tie is decided

Final Results will be declared after the end of the protest period. They will be posted on the Event Control Trailer, the club website and emailed to competitors who have provided an email address

To be classed as a finisher a competitor must have completed 50% of the tests in the car in which they started.

15 AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the event for

- FTD (fastest time of day)
- 1st in Class
- 2nd in Class (subject to 4 class entries)
- 3rd in Class (subject to 7 class entries)

No competitor may win more than one award.

16 IDENTIFICATION

Competitors will be provided with a competition number, which must be clearly displayed so the start and finish marshal can identify the competitor. Cars with two competing drivers must tape across the competition number not undertaking the test

17 PRACTICING

Practicing anywhere on or near the event site is prohibited and may lead to disqualification.

18 SITE RESTRICTIONS

The event venue is an operational port and commercial enterprise and both custom and excise as well as commercial restrictions apply to certain areas. These areas will be clearly signed and should not be entered.

19 INSURANCE EXCESS

In the event of a claim having been made for damage caused to third party property by any competitor, the organising club will pass on the insurance excess under the Motorsport UK Master Policy (currently £425 per incident) to the competitor/s involved.

20 GDPR

RDMC policy on GDPR is available on request. In signing this entry you are confirming your consent to us holding and using your personal data in connection with this event. Also, that you told the person whose details you have provided to us as an emergency contact for use in an emergency that their information is held by us.
